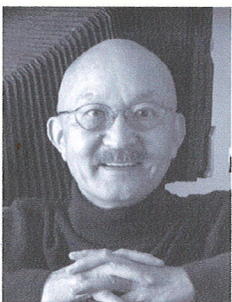
EARTHQUAKE AND TSUNAMI IN JAPAN
